

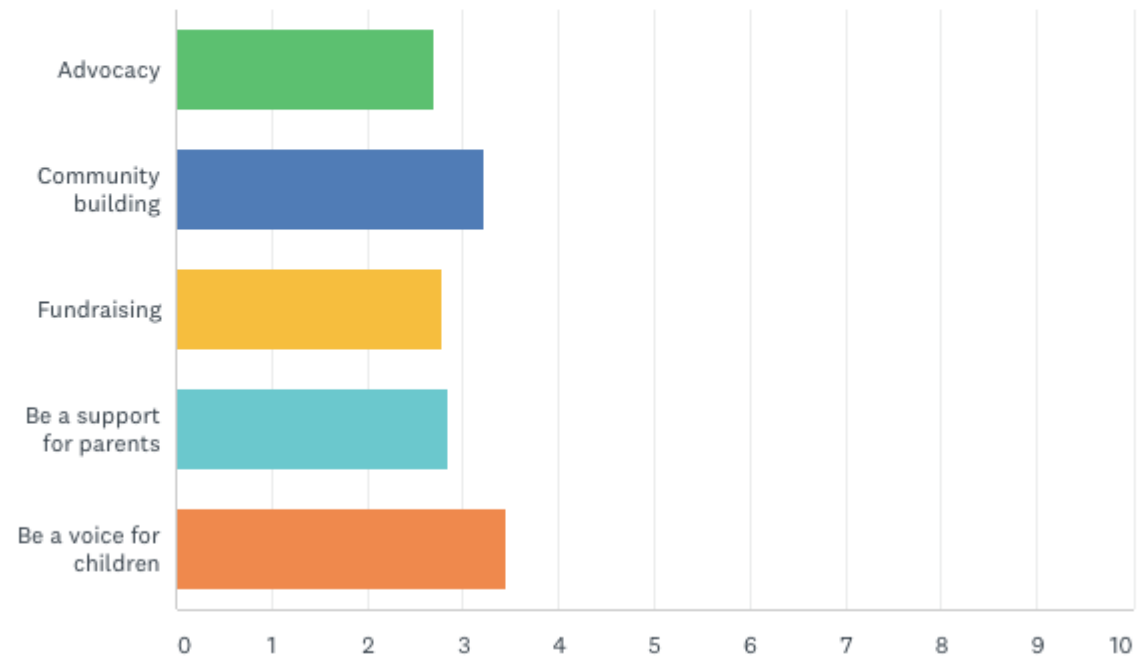

What do you expect your School Council to do? (please rank in order of importance)

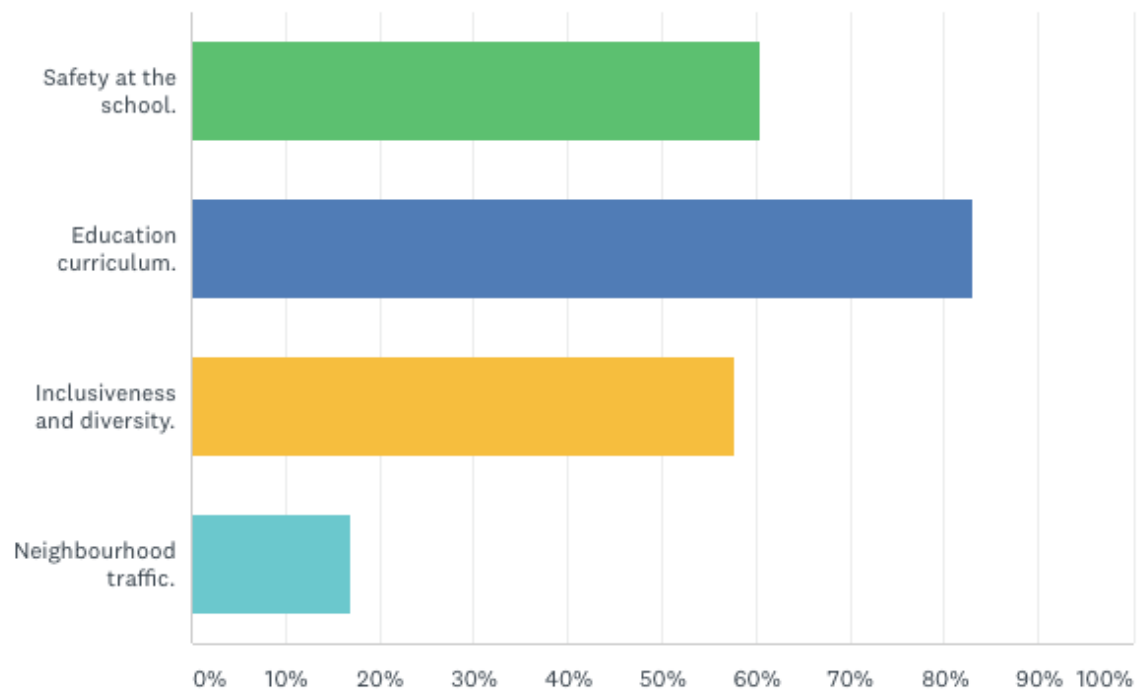
Answered: 70 Skipped: 2

What are your main concerns as a parent/guardian? (check all that apply)

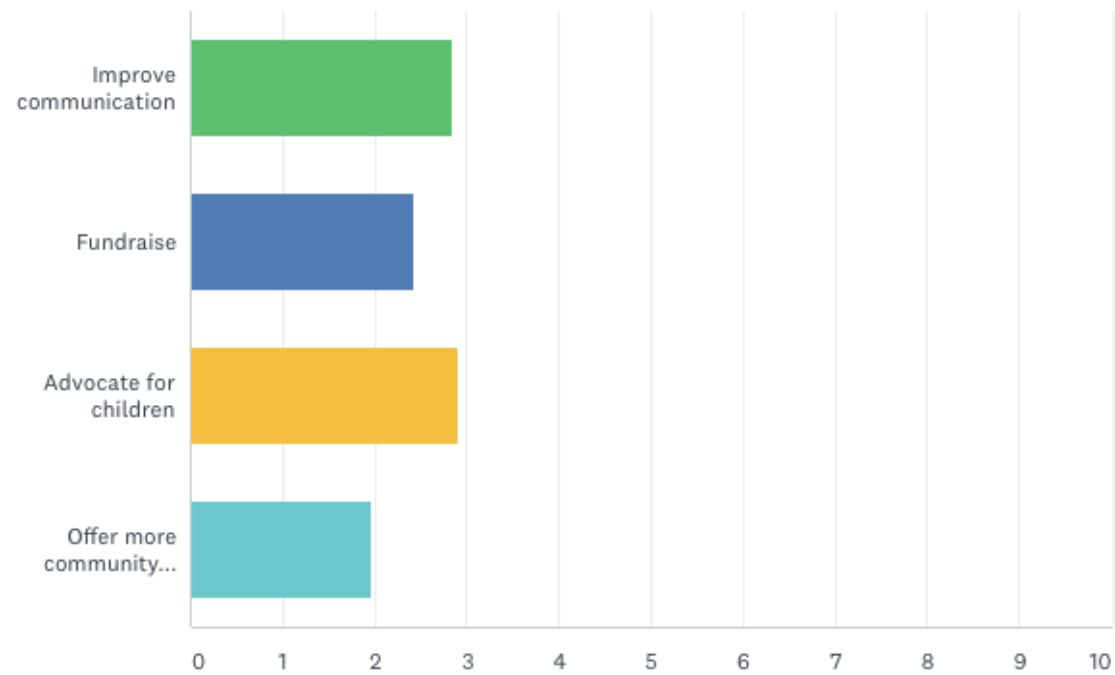
Answered: 71 Skipped: 1

(please rank in order of importance)

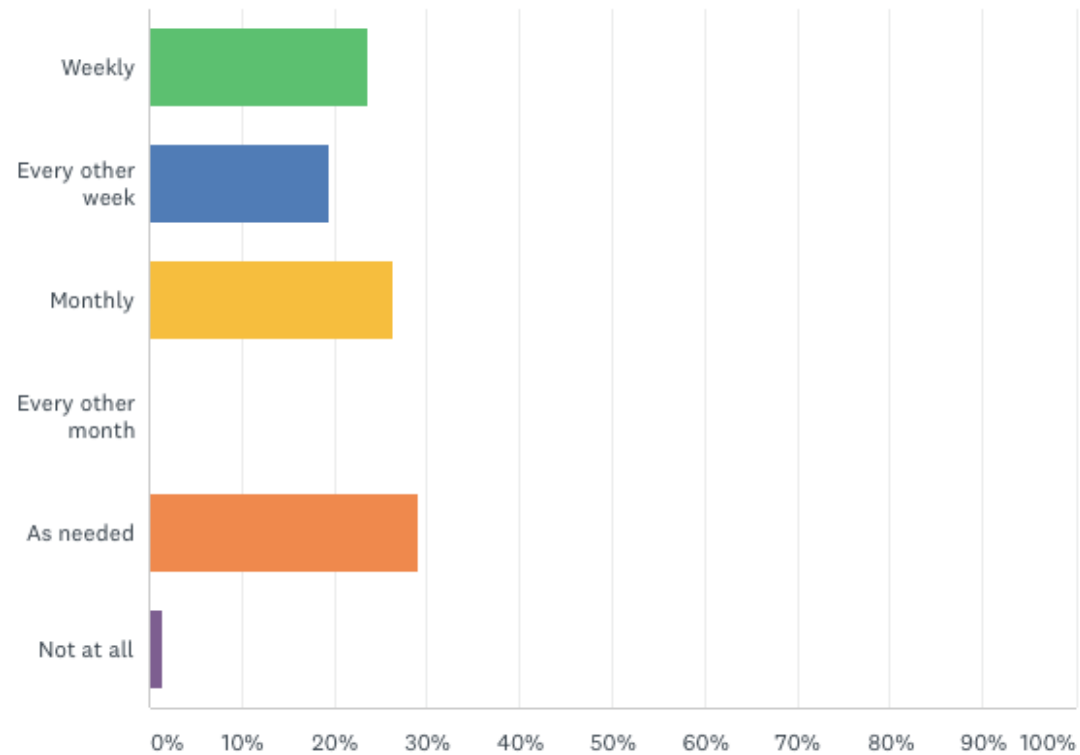
Answered: 68 Skipped: 4

How frequently do you want to hear from your Council? (choose one)

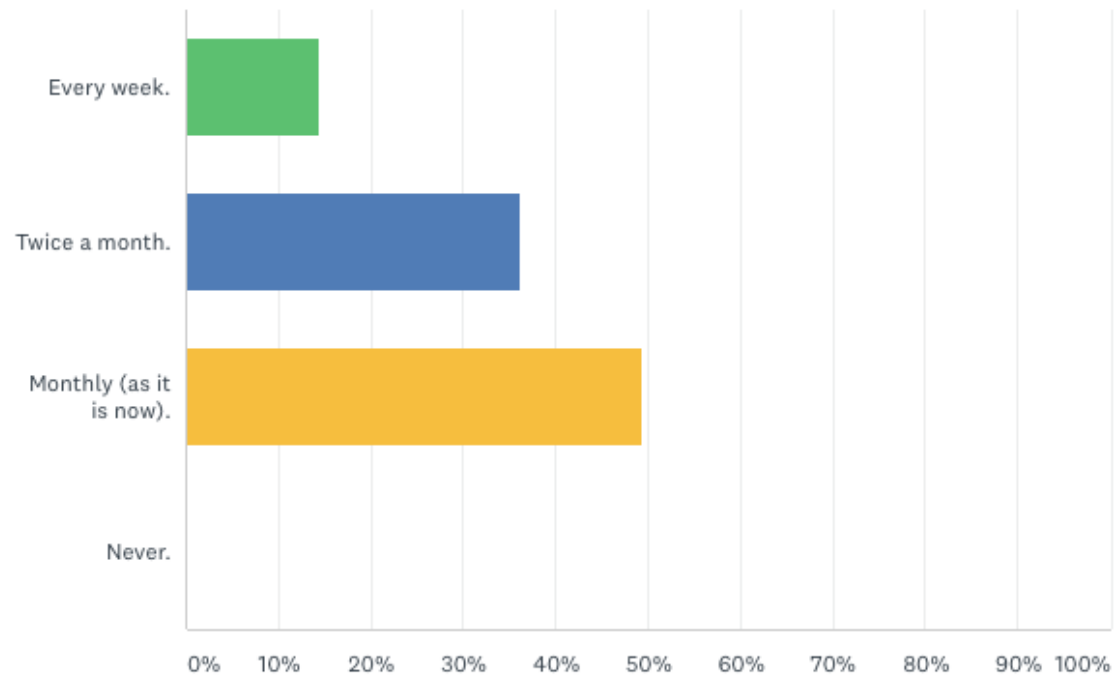
Answered: 72 Skipped: 0

How often would you like to see a lunch fundraiser, like Pizza Day? (choose one)

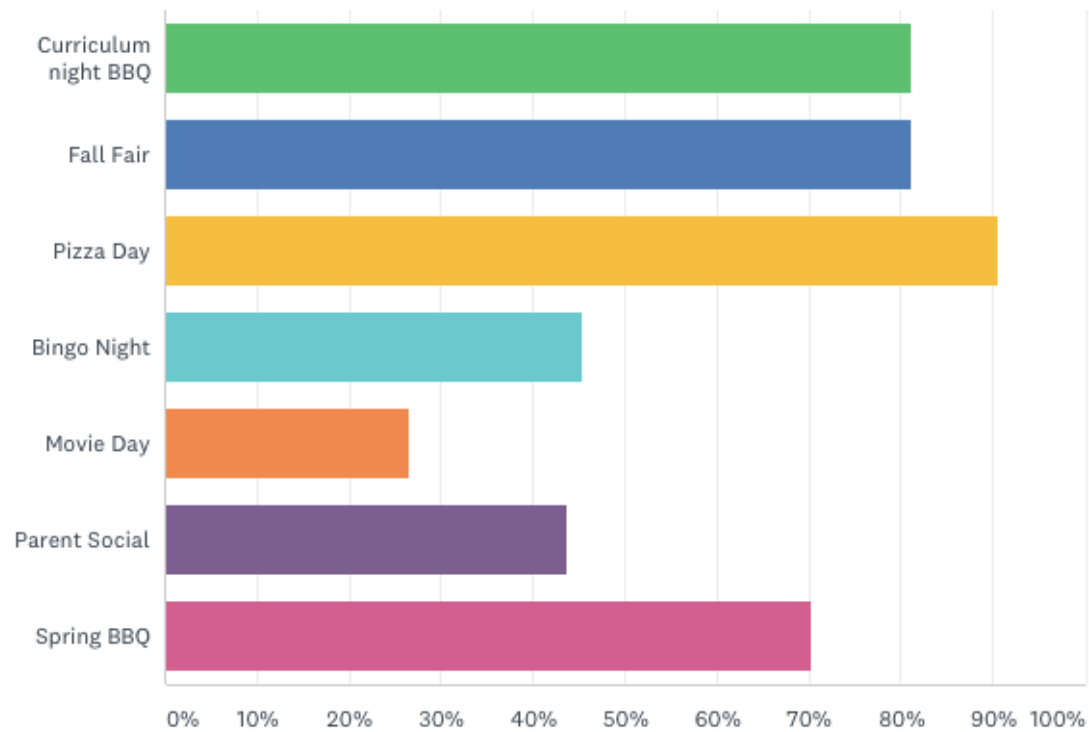
Answered: 69 Skipped: 3
